

## **Student Presentation Standards**

	EXPECTATIONS	EXAMPLES OF WHAT IS NOT ACCEPTABLE
WINTER/FORMAL UNIFORM	School blazer (and House ID ribbon) to be worn to and from the School every day:  i. The School jumper may be worn under the blazer but not as an outer garment while travelling to and from school  ii. While at school the blazer may be removed and hung in the locker  iii. After sport training the school tracksuit may be worn home, with the blazer in the school bag	<ul> <li>Dirty and crumpled blazer</li> <li>Arriving or leaving the School while not wearing the blazer</li> <li>Wearing the school tracksuit top / hoodie instead of a jumper or blazer</li> </ul>
	White shirt and school tie i. The top shirt button must be fastened ii. The tie is to be done up	<ul> <li>Shirt without buttons</li> <li>Dirty shirt</li> <li>Coloured t-shirt worn under the shirt</li> <li>Shirt buttons not fastened</li> <li>Shirt tail outside the trousers</li> </ul>
	School grey trousers with a black belt	<ul> <li>Trousers without a belt</li> <li>Trousers of a different shade of grey</li> <li>Dirty trousers</li> </ul>
SUMMER UNIFORM	School white and navy striped shirt	<ul> <li>Shirt without buttons</li> <li>Dirty shirt</li> <li>Shirt buttons not fastened</li> <li>Shirt tail outside the trousers</li> </ul>
	School navy shorts	Dirty shorts
PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNIFORM	<ul> <li>i. Refreshed PE uniform / Old PE uniform must be worn as a set (3-year transition – end of 2027)</li> <li>ii. Hoodie can be worn as per tracksuit top</li> <li>iii. The hood is not to be worn unless the conditions are cold and wintry</li> <li>iv. Beanie is not part of the PE uniform and not to be worn at school or to and from school.</li> <li>v. House polo to be worn on designated 'House Activity' days (Specific days will be identified)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>No mismatch of old / refreshed</li> <li>Sleeves stretched over the hands</li> <li>Wearing the beanie at times other than on camps or during sailing, rowing or winter sports training</li> </ul>
AT ALL TIMES	School navy pullover	<ul><li>Dirty or torn pullover</li><li>Sleeves stretched over the hands</li></ul>
	School socks	<ul><li>Sport socks of any kind</li><li>Multi-coloured casual socks</li></ul>
	Polished black leather shoes	<ul> <li>Boots, skate shoes, joggers</li> <li>Shoes that are not polished</li> <li>Shoes without laces, with torn, incomplete or untied laces</li> <li>Laces other than black</li> </ul>
	Make-up of any type is not to be worn when in school uniform.	<ul><li>Eyeline and foundation cannot be worn.</li><li>Nails on hands and toes cannot be coloured with nail polish or paint</li></ul>
	Jewellery is not to be worn. No piercings, rings, jewellery or wristbands are to be worn:  i. This applies to any student travelling to and from school, in school uniform, on a school activity, or whenever the student is in the School's care unless exempted by the Deputy Principal  ii. Watches, important religious and medical symbols are acceptable	<ul> <li>Rings on fingers, bangles, bracelets or necklaces</li> <li>Rings, studs or sleepers including those through ears or other body parts</li> </ul>
	HAIR In keeping with the statement on dress and appearance, hairstyles should be tidy and not grown or groomed in an extreme or exaggerated fashion. Hair should be regularly cut, kept neat and above the shirt collar. It must be their natural colour and not dyed or coloured, worn off the face and should not be able to obstruct sight. Hair should be cut no shorter than a number 3 cut, nor have significant contrast in length. Hair should not be tucked behind the ears nor need to be tied back in any way in order to play sport. Students should be clean shaven at all times.
